Throughout our rich history, the School District of Shorewood has been recognized as having one of the strongest performing arts programs in the state of Wisconsin. This is a standard that the music staff here at SIS is excited to be a part of. Our success in this regard, has been due to the overwhelming support of our community, diligence and support of the administration, hard work of our students, and the attention to detail of the performing arts staff.

As part of our continuing effort to maintain that strong arts tradition, all performance music groups at SIS have standard requirements regarding the appropriate clothing to be worn at concerts.

This note is intended to clarify the concert attire requirements for choir.

It is the students' responsibility to provide their own concert attire. The following guidelines are to be followed when choosing the components of your concert dress. Please keep in mind concerts are formal events. Variation from these guidelines is unacceptable and will result in a lowered concert grade. If your family needs help in securing concert dress items, we have been fortunate to have collected some gently used components that students may be able to use. Simply let Mr. Clark know your need, and we will work to help students get the assistance they require. Below you will find the requirements for both men and women.

Women

1. **Black** dress shoes
2. **Black** stockings or tights
- 3a. A **black** tea-length (mid-calf) skirt (or longer)
or
- 3b. **Black** dress pants (no jeggings, leggings, yoga pants, jean cut, skinny cut, or corduroy's)
- 4a. A **white** 3/4 length sleeve or long-sleeved blouse
or
- 4b. A **White** sweater or sweater set.
5. A small **Red** accent piece (scarf, shoes, belt, hair accessory etc.)

Men

1. **Black** dress shoes
2. **Black** dress socks
3. **Black** dress pants with a **Black** belt (no athletic pants, jeans, corduroy's, or skinny pants.)
4. A **white** dress shirt
5. a **RED BOW** tie (please no clips ties, zipper ties, or elastic if possible) I will teach the boys how to tie their tie.

To ensure that students have what they need, there will be a graded concert attire check in December. I have found that by having this check well in advance of the concert, students have what they need and there is much less last minute stress on the part of families to have their students prepared and properly outfitted for the concert. Additionally, if there are any problems that need to be addressed, students have adequate time to fix them prior to the concert.

On **Wednesday, December 1**, all choir students are to wear their concert attire to school to be checked. At that time, I will be sure every student has the appropriate components they need. Once the students have been checked in, they will be given the opportunity to change into their regular clothes for the remainder of the day.
